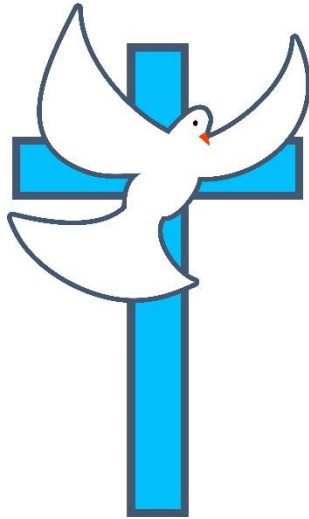

## NOTES FROM THE PARISH NURSE

Dear Friends in Christ:

I hope you are all enjoying the summer with all the activities that occur during this season.

*Some health tips to reduce soreness after exercise.*

Start easy, especially if you haven't exercised in a while. Start with a 5-10 minute walk. Start with limited practice swings instead of a full match if you haven't played tennis for a while. For strength training, start with weights you can easily lift 12 to 15 times.

Increase slowly. Follow the 10% rule. If you walk briskly for 20 minutes a day, walk 22 minutes each day the following week. In 5 weeks, you'll be up to 30 minutes a day. Same goes for strength training.

Listen to your body. Adapt your exercise routine to the needs of your changing body.

Use proper technique and equipment. Take lessons, wear properly fitting equipment and appropriate shoes.

Warm up and cool down. Perform light movements to help muscles adjust to activity, and end sessions with gentler movements.

Mix up your routine. Add variety to reduce the risk of overuse injury and to keep muscles prepared for trying something new or more challenging. (Info from Mayo Clinic Health Letter, July 2018)
