## Winterim week

**Lifetime Leadership/Service/Balance. Design, Crease and Create; A Short Artistic Journey Exploring Motifs, Origami and Fiber Sculpture. Exploring Teaching. “OK Mister, I’ll Make a Man out of You!”.**

These were some of the course selections from this year’s Winterim session at LHS. Winterim is held the first week back after Christmas break where students can choose their unique pursuit of interest from subject offerings by the Lutheran High faculty. Students acquire new knowledge, expand learning beyond the classroom, and explore interests. Each course is a full day of experiments and experiences, field trips, movies, and even learning a few new skills. Also included this year was *“Coach’em Up”*, *Basic Wilderness Survival 101*, *Work It Out Extravaganza — Mind & Body*, *The Inside and Out of What is Happening in Sheboygan County*, *The Olympic Games*, and *“Oooh...Something Shiny”*.

As in previous years, LHS hosted a variety of speakers during the Winterim week. This year we were blessed to have two special speakers share their message of how Christ has impacted their lives.

The first speaker was Dr. Micah Parker of *Trust Guy Ministries*. His life has had many trials including an unexplained heart issue which took his first wife with no warning. His talks were entitled **Praise Trust and**

**Adversity Trust**. He spoke on how we can trust God in good times and in tough times without wavering, with many Biblical references. He speaks nationwide and will be at the National LCMS Youth Gathering in Minneapolis this summer.

Our second speaker also had a strong message for our students. Mr. David Cooks was a normal teen who enjoyed playing basketball as a teenager, but suddenly, became a paraplegic after a unique condition that attacked his spine. Through faith and family he talked about the blessings and opportunities he has enjoyed throughout his life. He focused on how to be grateful in all circumstances.

We were fortunate to incorporate a class led by Mr. Aaron Anger, LHS Alumni and local businessman, who guided students through experiences in our community, visiting factories and businesses in the county. Principal Holzheimer also led a class during Winterim, exploring service organizations and seeing what great things are happening in Sheboygan County. Thank you to the businesses and organizations that allowed us to visit.

Overall it’s always a very interesting week. Students write a paper at the end of the Winterim week for a grade in the course, but we hope they gain wisdom and insight into new and challenging topics. It’s another way of preparing our students for Christian Leadership in their future vocations.

## WPCP Voucher Income Limits for 2019-2020

Family Size	Max. Yearly Income*
2	\$36,212
3	\$45,716
4	\$55,220
5	\$64,724

For each additional member add \$9,504.

\* Adjusted Gross Income

If the child's parents/legal guardians are married, their income is reduced by \$7,000 (family income minus \$7,000 then compared to the chart) when determining income eligibility for the program. Family size includes parents/legal guardians and their children by birth, marriage or adoption that reside in the same household as the student applicant.

Family income includes the income of the child's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) that reside in the same household as the student applicant.

The application will ask for last year's tax return, or it will use the previous year. Contact the LHS office if you have questions regarding eligibility.
