Dear Friends in Christ:

I hope you are all coping with the late start of winter. This is the time of year where we start to look forward to spring, not snow every other day.

So let's talk about hot cereal, what's new and what to look for on labels.

- Look for all or mostly whole grain. The exception is grits, cream of wheat or rice.
- Skip or skimp on added sugars. As some labels don't yet have the info, so anything over 0 to 3 grams is usually added. You can sweeten your own with fruits.
- Check the sodium, most flavored varieties add salt, so again add your own fruit and nuts to boost flavor.

There are also many new "old" grains in cereals. Some are quinoa (keen-wah), amaranth, buckwheat, bulgur, kamut, chia seeds, pumpkin seeds, almond butter, etc. added to cereals. Give them a try.

You can also try "overnight" oats by adding oats to milk (and yogurt for creamy texture) and storing in refrigerator for a cold cereal in the morning.
