NOTES FROM THE PARISH NURSE

Dear Friends in Christ:

Christ is risen!!! Easter blessings to all.

The truth about blood thinners – how to use them effectively.

These drugs are used to dissolve existing clots and for atrial fibrillation (Afib).

Warfarin (Coumadin & generic) was the most commonly used, but it carries risks of severe and even deadly brain bleeds. Users need blood tests weekly to start, and then at least monthly. Certain foods must be avoided such as kale and spinach and others which contain Vitamin K.

Newer drugs on the market include apixaban (Eliquis), dabigatran (Pradaxa), and rivaroxaban (Xarelto) for use with Afib. People with mechanical heart valves, and moderate to severe mitral valve narrowing should still use warfarin.

These newer drugs have less risky side effects, 50 percent less likely to have brain bleed and they don't require frequent blood tests or dietary changes. They can still affect the risk of bleeding and can affect kidney and liver function, so blood tests usually are taken twice a year.

Smart steps to take are to know your dosage, to make sure you are on the lowest dose needed, take at the same time every day, and know what to do if you miss a dose, and report side effects. There is a risk of GI bleeding, so make sure your doctor knows if you are taking antidepressants (Paxil or Zoloft) and don't take aspirin or ibuprofen unless your doctor instructs you.

Also be wise about activity. Contact sports are a no-no, but skiing or cycling may be okay if wearing protective gear.

There are drugs to combat the effects of bleeding if you have significant bleeding from an accident or emergency surgery.
