Tuition Tips!

- ◆ **Lock in the '19/'20 tuition rate when paying by Jan. 31, 2020.** Take advantage of the savings on any tuition increase for future years by paying this year's rate in full. Contact the LHS Business office at 920-452-3323 to pre-pay for your child or grandchild's tuition.
- ◆ Be sure to take advantage of the Wisconsin tax deduction law for Private School Tuition costs on form PS-1 with your State tax return. LHS families can claim up to \$10,000 per year in tuition and book fees as a subtraction. Contact your tax professional for more information.
- ◆ LHS also participates in the Statewide School Voucher Program. The open application period begins Feb.3, 2020. Find the online application link on our website at www.lutheranhigh.com beginning Feb. 3.
